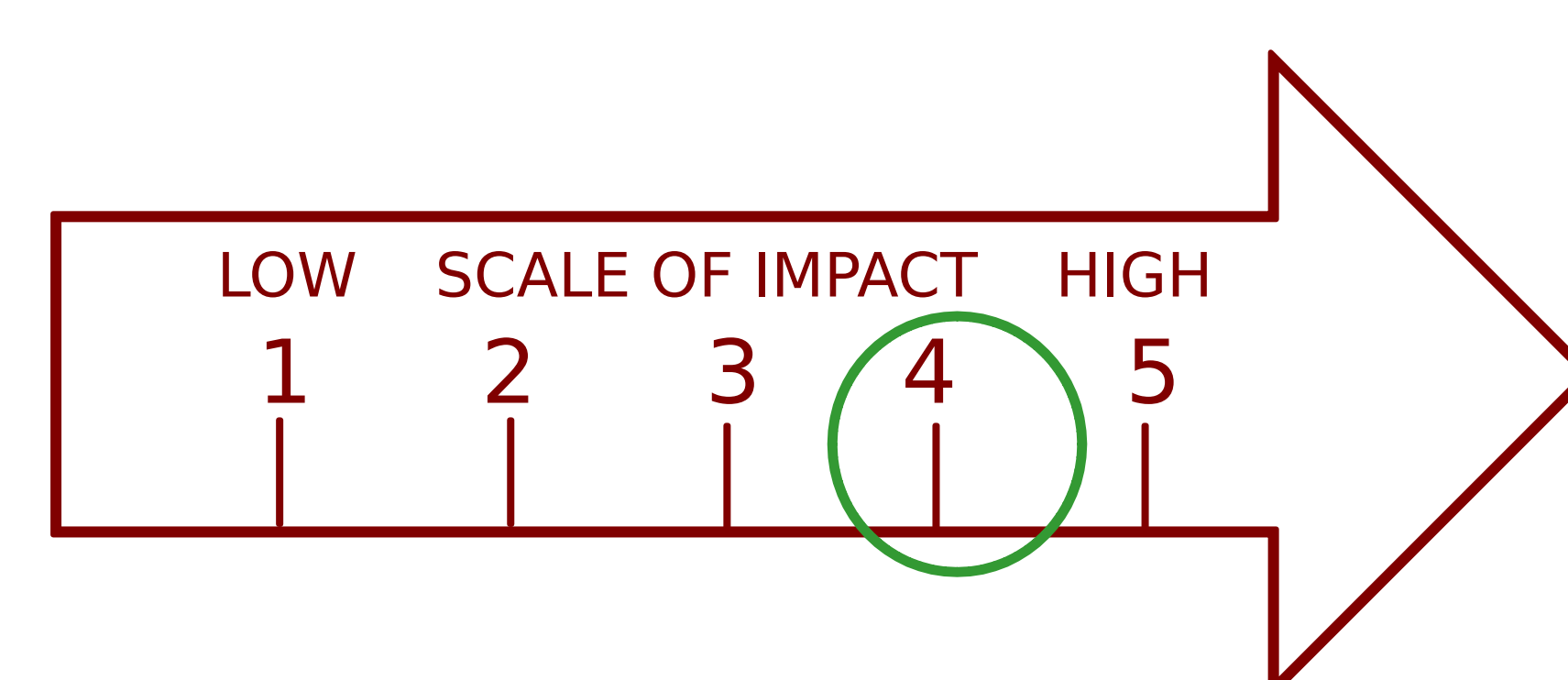
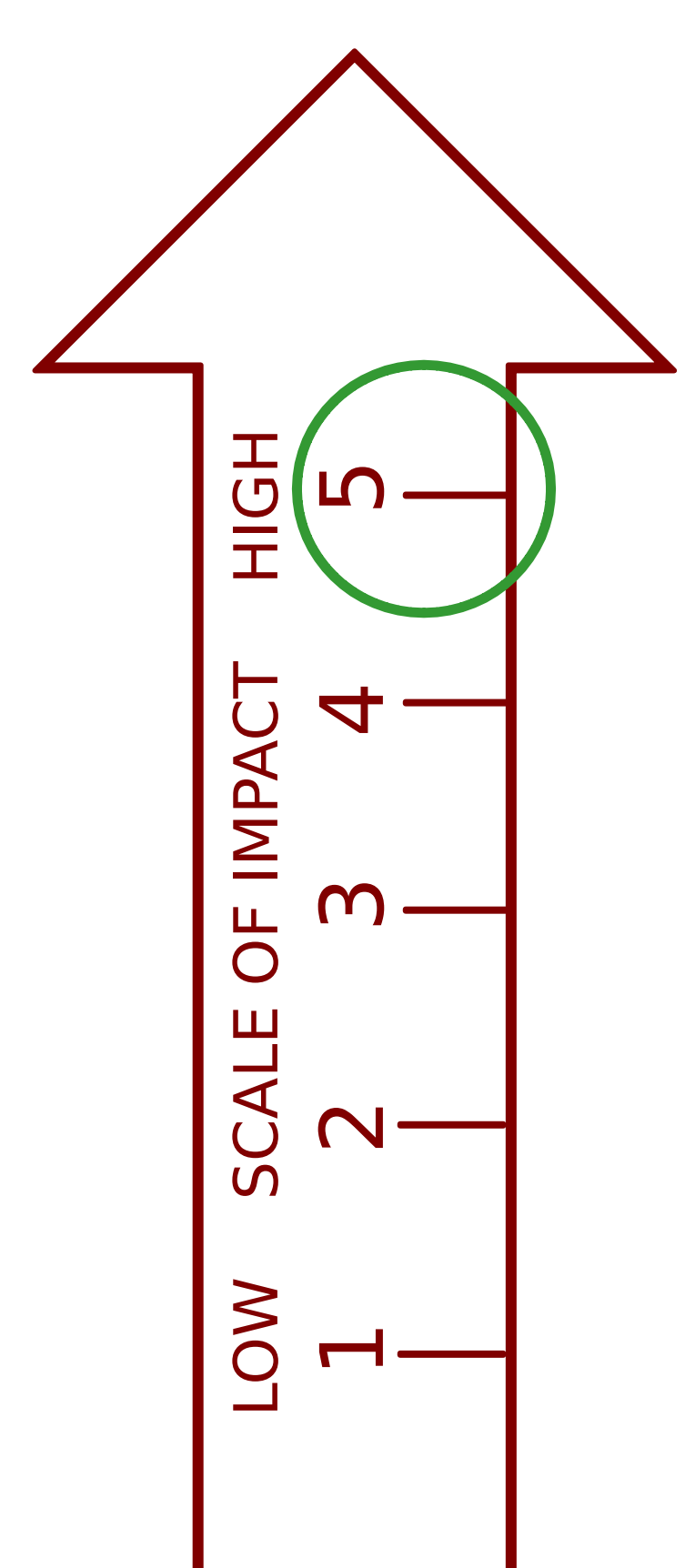

- Improved educators will deliver new models of teaching and training to learners as well as newly qualified staff; expanding a network of such trained workers

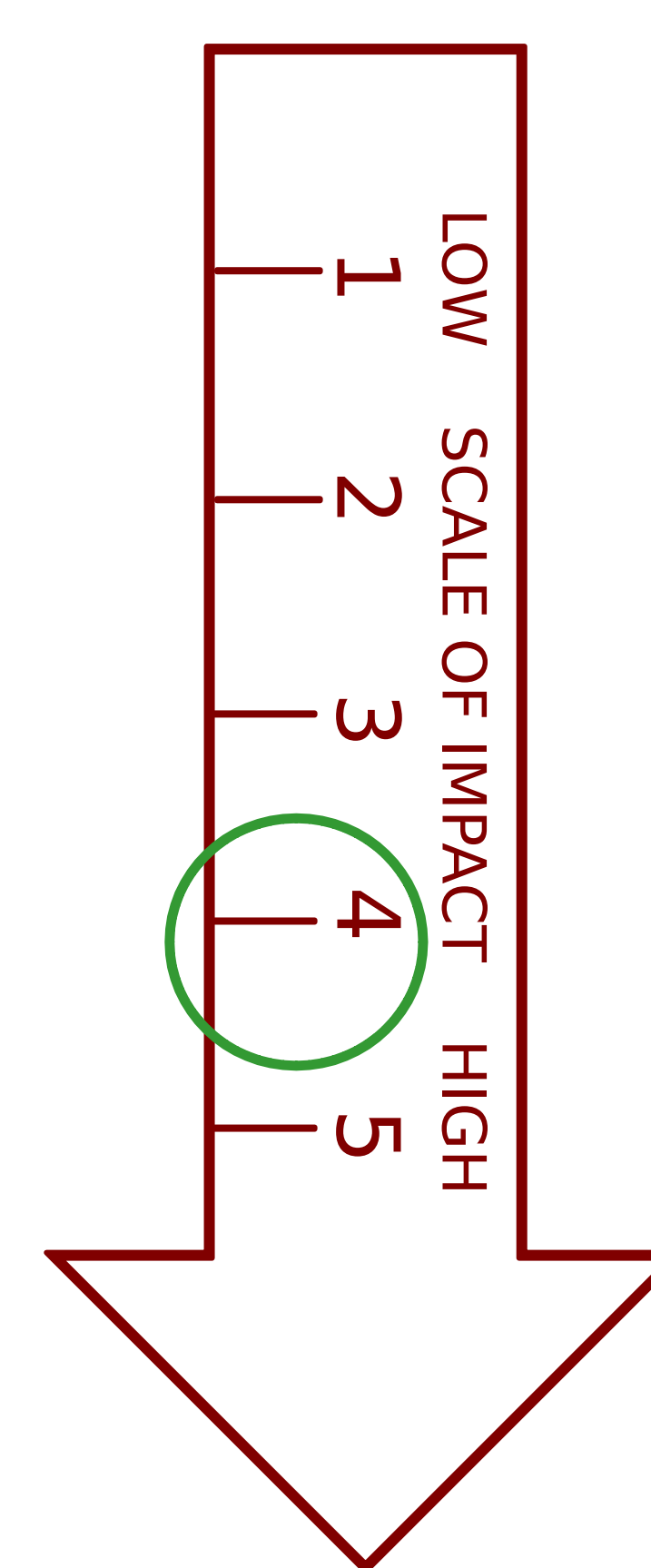
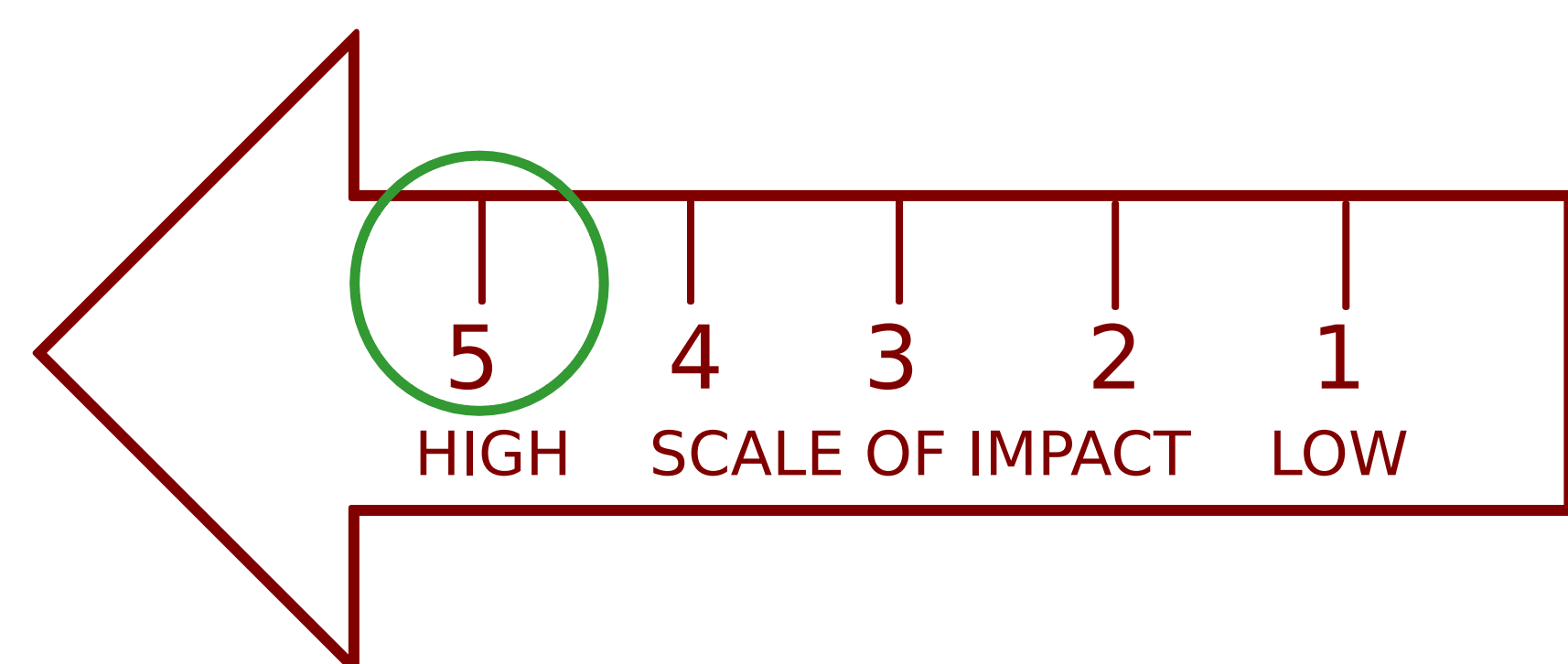
