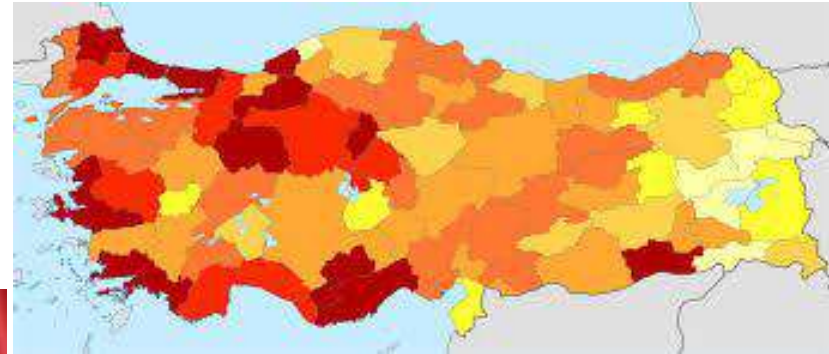

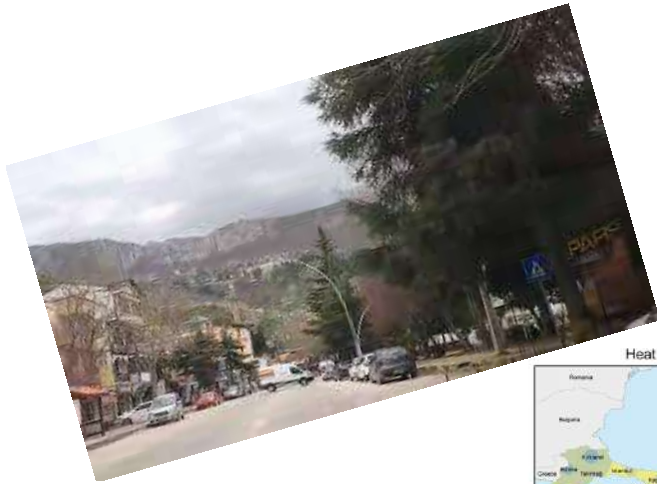
# Largest cities (alphabetically): Ankara, Antalya, Istanbul, Izmir, Samsun



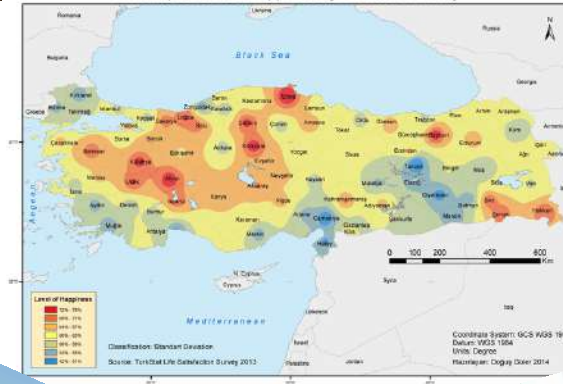
# Amasya – center of a province

# Basic data

- **Gümüşhacıköy** is located in the westernmost district of **Amasya Province** of Turkey, 20 km from the **larger town of Merzifon**. It covers an area of 653 km<sup>2</sup>, and the population (2010 census) is 24,806 of which 14,525 live in the town of Gümüşhacıköy
- The name Gümüşhacıköy is an amalgamation of two separate villages **Gümüş (silver)** and **Hacıköy (the village of pilgrims)**.

# History

- prosperity during the 13th and 14th centuries due to the nearby silver mines
- the Seljuks and the Ilkhans minted coins in the town, then known as Gümüşbazar
- men of Gümüşhacıköy were lost in the Balkan Wars and the First World War
- today small town in attractive countryside
- successive generations migrate leaving an aging and shrinking population behind.

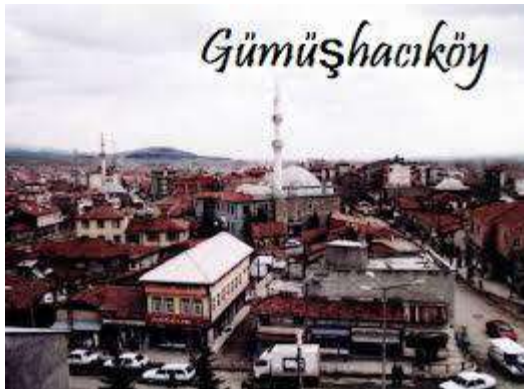
- Tombs of the kings of Pontus

# Architectural sightseeings

# Average values

- The climate is warm and temperate in Gümüşhacıköy. The rain in Gümüşhacıköy falls mostly in the winter, with relatively little rain in the summer. The average annual temperature is 11.0 °C in Gümüşhacıköy. In a year, the average rainfall is 435 mm.
- The warmest month of the year is July, with an average temperature of 20.4 °C. At 0.5 °C on average, January is the coldest month of the year.

# Our hotel in words...

# Turkish specialities - food

- Pide, which can be made with minced meat (together with onion, chopped tomatoes, parsley and spices), kashar cheese, spinach, white cheese, pieces of meat, braised meat (kavurma), sucuk, pastirma or/and eggs put on rolled-out dough

# Turkish specialities – drinks

sahlep –from wild orchid, medicinal because of the ingredient glucomannan, treats respiratory problems, strengthens

the heart and brain; stops diarrhea, heats up; it is combined with ginger and cinnamon



boza- non-alcoholic and refreshing drinks made from corn (corn flour), yeast, sugar and water



# Drinks II

Tea - black is the most popular;  
served hot and distributed  
everywhere



Coffee - so-called Turkish coffee  
is boiled in hot water,  
served with a lot of foam on top



Ayran - national soft drink,  
contains yogurt, water and salt





# Bonton – verbal and nonverbal communication

- If you ask the Turk if he has anything, and he nods and bows his tongue, that means no.
- If Turks explain to you how big something was, they will show it by bending their left arm upwards slightly to bend their elbows, "cutting" it to the right, demonstrating the magnitude of what they explain to you, usually with the words *bu frame* (this much).
- When Turks turn their palms up and connect all fingers with their thumbs and wiggle back and forth it means that something is delicious, beautiful..

# Bonton II

- Since the worship at religious ceremonies is produced by touching the floor with forehead, it is important that the floor is clean. Therefore, when visiting a mosque, or someone's home, shoes should be taken off!
- Women – put a headscarf in a mosque!
- You often need to disinfect your hands!
- Extend your right hand when handling it!

# Turkish Lira

- Currency unit lira = 100 kurush



- Coins - 1kr, 5kr, 10kr, 25kr, 50kr, 1 lira
- Bills – 5,10, 20, 50, 100, 200 lira



- Ankyra coin from the Roman emperor Galien. The name Ankara, the capital of Turkey, is a derivative of the ancient Greek name for the anchor - "Άγκυρα"
- Exchange rate TRY – HRK = 85.26 – 100
- Exchange rate TRY - € = 634 - 100

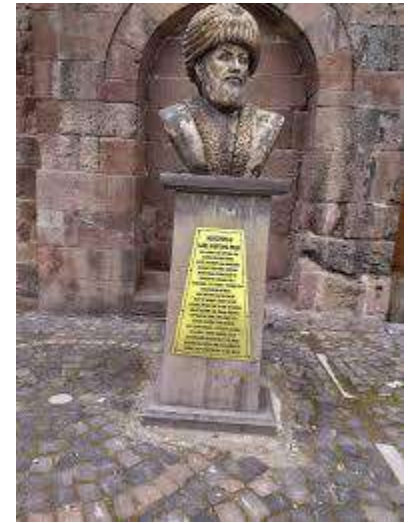
# Merzifon Karamustafa Pasha State Hospital is also near by

- The Grand Vizier Kara Mustafa, born in Merzifon, was an excellent warlord, but was defeated at Vienna in 1683 and killed in Belgrade, at the request of Sultan Mehmed IV for failure.
- Kemal Pasha Ataturk nevertheless sympathized with him as the only great tactician after Suleiman the Magnificent
