Purpose and tasks of this meeting were to: Discuss/Analyze project's results – MC report, ongoing activities and dissemination's results; project's website; present financial details, introduce the obligatory documentation for the final report; MC report about interim reports and data about activities, dissemination, and all the documents related to the topics of TM's, visit teaching/trainig hospitals, create photo/video material of Turkish wound care dressing techniques during TM, present Cultural presentation. Outcomes were: Latinka Križnik held lecture about financial issues of the project and presented all the necessary documentation for a final report, gave report about so far gathered documentation; she also explained the budget plan for future national ME. Marinela Labaš presented the total data collection made so far from each partner's activities, introduced forms for last report and the content of project's web site. Labaš and Beck evaluated the MC reports contents described the final version's form. After a short discussion all partners agreed that for each national ME we should include video conference call from other partners. Practical outcomes: meeting with head of the education's department for Amasya Province, introducing to Turkish educational system, specially vocational part; visiting partner's school, introduction made Adnan Yavuz, comparing with Croatian and Slovenian school – classrooms, library, equipment for nursing student's education etc.; visiting State hospital in Gumushacikoy, State hospital in Amasya and Merzifon State Hospital vocational teachers from each partner institution were observing wound care and dressing techniques, application of tools and equipments, procedures in certain departments. They also had a brief lecture followed by short discussion about the working conditions for nurses in Turkey, and about content of our Manual. Visiting Amasya University for a presentation about healthcare staff education in Turkey in general. Cultural tour in Amasya after a short presentation from Muhammet Cakmak. Distribution of printed Manual version in English, 50 for each partner. Presentation of digital versions, in all 4 languages. Participants (vocational teachers from Croatia, Slovenia and Germany with Turkish Project team) expressed admiration for nurses that take care of patients with such wounds. From Croatia three vocational teachers participated – Danica Hudin, Nikolina Matić and Ankica Vukelić and as observers there were Croatian coordinators of a Project, from Turkey Muhammet Cakmak, Adnan Yavuz, from Slovenia Lucija Matič, Martina Scrabec, Tatjana Hrovat Ahac and from Germany Nadine Miersbach, Raphael Dittrich and Jenifer Burzik. The evaluation was made at the end of the meeting before closing ceremony. Results will be included in MC report.



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
